All her Dbs members are fine and they also send their greetings to you all. Allen has three Dbs' that she meets on a weekly basis in Kuru.

Many girls have come to Allen for both spiritual and physical help and it's through these engagements that God has used Allen to spread the good News encouraging them through scriptures, though their physical needs are still standing but we believe God will soon intervene in their families and personal lives.

Allen conducted service opportunities in the community where she visited some families sharing sugar, soap, salt, rice and bread for Easter celebrations with the families. Ministering in a Muslim community hinders her from taking pictures.

Allen also conducted home visits to the elderly and their families offering prayer and the word to them after extending a helping hand of food and soap during the Easter period.

The lord has opened more ministerial doors for Linda mainly through her friend Miriam who is her Swahili and Arabic teacher that when she visited her she found other four people staying close to Miriam's Rental these friends to Miriam like singing and through this relationship they have begun singing songs about Jesus though Linda hasn't begun sharing the Gospel with them she's believing God to start sharing with them as soon as possible keep praying with Her.

Linda managed to visit a certain village called Buyu where she met two ladies and had an interaction, thereafter these ladies invited her for their Iddi celebration, though she failed to turn up for the celebration but she thanks God for softening these hearts too and she will continue to befriend them for kingdom purposes. All our new missionaries in training are doing well and they are taking on the perspectives course via what sup on a weekly basis meeting three days with Robert for their classes.

However, our missionary work is facing a number of challenges in all our efforts to spread the gospel, right now the situation is becoming hard for ministry in the poverty stricken areas of Yumbe, Bunia and Malindi due to the financial instability caused by the lockdown, Allen is facing a challenge of inadequate provision to help the people she minister's too, the same case in Malindi and Bunia Congo where Borad and William are serving many people are relatively poor and Kenya being a semi-desert country they are attacked by many sicknesses and illnesses, there is a rising need of meeting the physical needs of these people as we endeavor to Spiritually minister to them.

Up to now we are still believing and working upon Tendo Joseph's travel to Chad, this has been delayed by the restrictions on entering the country; the country has no embassy here in Uganda and for someone to board must have an authorization letter from the authorities of chad to get the Visa on arrival we are praying and still working on getting this done keep us in your prayers.

We can't appreciate you enough for all your continued prayers and support towards this ministry; could you kindly consider praying for Chad to open up for the work of the

Gospel, more boldness to witness Christ, more provision towards all the mission work and God's protection.

We appreciate the Lord for this great opportunity of being part of what He's doing among the unreached may the good Lord bless you all. We thank you for desiring to hear from us.
